

COVID Case Update

We had 17 new infections reported since Thursday morning, 9 from NYS and 8 from positive self-reported home tests to Warren County Health Services. Our rolling 7-day average of new positives is 16 currently. One individual was hospitalized as of Thursday, unchanged from the prior report.

Capital Region COVID hospitalizations are at 97, 9 fewer than the last NYS update.
