

### COVID Data Update

We had 61 new Warren County resident COVID-19 infections reported since Friday morning, 38 from NYS and 23 from positive self-reported home tests to Warren County Health Services. Our rolling 7-day average of new infections is 20.

Nine Warren County residents were hospitalized as of Monday, two more than Friday. One is critically ill.

Capital Region COVID hospitalizations were at 160 on Friday, 3 fewer than the previous day.
