

### COVID Data Update

We had 21 new Warren County resident COVID-19 infections reported since Thursday morning, 15 from NYS and 6 from positive self-reported home tests to Warren County Health Services.

Our rolling 7-day average of new infections is 17.

Eight Warren County residents were hospitalized as of Thursday, two more than Wednesday.

One is critically ill.

Capital Region COVID hospitalizations were at 186 on Thursday, seven more than the last report.
