

COVID Data Update

Good morning. We had 11 new Warren County resident COVID-19 infections reported since Thursday morning, 10 from NYS and one home test reported to Warren County Health Services. Our rolling 7-day average of new infections is 15.

Five Warren County residents were hospitalized as of Thursday, unchanged from the last report. None are critically ill.

Capital Region COVID hospitalizations were at 147 as of Thursday, three more than the previous report.

The CDC's weekly COVID-19 community level update for this week, issued Thursday afternoon, deemed Warren County to have ["low" community COVID levels](#), an improvement from last week's "medium" classification.
