WHEREAS, the Assessor has been treated as an employee of each and both Town(s) during 2016, and WHEREAS, the Towns have recognized certain impracticalities and inconsistencies in this arrangement, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board approves amendment to the Agreement so that the Assessor is deemed to be solely an employee of the Town of Horicon with the Town of Bolton reimbursing the Town of Horicon for 50% of all salary, benefits and related expenses of employment, and be it further RESOLVED, that the Town Board requests similar Resolution from the Bolton Town Board so authorizing, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this employment arrangement continue for the term of the Agreement contingent upon continued reimbursement of the Town of Horicon by the Town of Bolton.

RESOLVED, that Town Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to draft revisions to the Agreement consistent with this Resolution and the Supervisor is hereby authorized to sign the amended Agreement on behalf of the Town.
