Supervisor Simpson called the Budget workshop meeting to order at 5:00 pm and the Board reviewed the proposed 2015 Budget line by line.

## **General Budget:**

Town Board – There is a proposed 2% increase in salary for Town Board members. There is a proposed increase of \$150.00 in Contractual for training and mileage.

Justice – There is a proposed 2% increase in salary for the Justice and a 3% increase for the Court Clerk. There is an increase in equipment for items needed.

Supervisor – There is a proposed 2% increase in salary. Contractual has been increased \$2,000.00.

Director of Finance – There is a proposed 3% increase in salary for the Supervisor's Secretary/Deputy Tax Collector.

Assessor - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary.

Town Clerk/Tax Collector - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary.

Personnel Floater - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary.

Board of Review – There is a proposed increase in Personal Services due to the need for an alternate member. Contractual has been increased for training.

Buildings – There is a proposed 3% increase in salary. There is a proposed amount in Equipment of \$7,000.00 for a floor cleaner and a new phone system.

Ambulance (A4540.4) – Supervisor Simpson noted that this code has a proposed increase of \$10,000.00 based on a request by the NW Emergency Squad.

Superintendent of Highways - There is a proposed 2% increase in salary.

Street Lights – This code has been increased due to an increase in electric rates.

Publicity – There is a proposed budget amount of \$6,000 for the Chamber of Commerce contract and \$5,000.00 for the lights around the pond.

Special Publicity – The proposed budget amount for Special Publicity includes \$2,600 for the Chamber of Commerce (\$1,000-website, \$1,000-Pug Parade, \$500-Duck Race, \$100-VIP dinner), \$250 for the North Country Arts Center, \$10,000 for Horicon Day, \$4,000 for the Tri-Lakes Alliance Brant Lake Winter Carnival, \$1,000 for Tri-Lakes Alliance Rum Runner's Weekend, \$8,000 to man the Boat Wash Station, \$1,600 for the Adirondack Shindig, \$2,600 for signs for Adirondack, and \$2,950 unallocated.

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Museum - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary.

Adult Recreation - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary for the Librarian. There is also an allotment for a Library Assistant to work 3 hours per week.

Zoning – There is a proposed 3% increase in salary for both the Zoning Administrator and the Zoning Clerk.

Insect Department – There is a proposed budget amount of \$32,000 for Boat Stewards for coverage seven days a week (\$16,000 for Schroon Lake and \$16,000 for Brant Lake), \$12,700 for milfoil control on Schroon Lake, \$20,000 for milfoil control on Brant Lake, and \$21,000 for BTI. \*\*The amount for BTI was removed later in the meeting and moved into the Highway budget.

Refuse & Garbage - There is a proposed 3% increase in salary.

Beautification - There is a proposed increase in salary to allow for more hours.

## Highway Budget:

General Repairs - There is a proposed increase in Personal Services based on the Union contract. After lengthy discussion, the Board decided to move \$11,000 out of Insect Control Contractual (originally allocated for BTI) and put it in General Repair-Contractual which increases this code to \$216,000.00.

Machinery - There was a request for a new tandem, but the Town still owes on the BAN for the last truck they bought so they did not budget for a new tandem.

Snow Removal – There was a proposed budget amount of \$80,000, but after discussion on salt usage the Board decided to move \$10,000 out of Insect Control Contractual (originally allocated for BTI) and put it in Snow Removal-Contractual which increases this code to \$90,000.

Supervisor Simpson added that in order to balance this Budget he had to take \$250,000 out of Surplus. Councilman Olson asked if this will keep the Town under the 2% tax cap, and Supervisor Simpson said it would.

<u>Adjourn...</u> There being no further business to attend to the meeting was adjourned at 7:50PM by MOTION of Councilperson Olson and Councilperson Hill, all in favor.
