Area Variance for shoreline setback to place a concrete structure 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 3' to anchor dock for hoisting which will sit 1' from the shoreline where 50' is required.

Roger Houck spoke on behalf of Christopher McDermott for a proposed single concrete structure (1) for hoisting the dock out of the water in the winter. Roger Houck stated that this property is on a point and has a very steep bank. The last two years Christopher McDermott had a bubbler to try to protect the dock and has tried a wheeled dock removing the dock during the winter and neither has worked. This year the ice destroyed the dock. Basically what Chris McDermott is proposing is a concrete structure 4 ½' x 3 ½' x 3' to anchor the dock for hoisting the dock out of the water in the winter to prevent damage to the dock.

Chairman Gary Frenz asked Roger Houck if the concrete is poured or precast. Roger responded it will be poured.

Vice-Chair Cheryl Erickson asked if the size of the dock will change and Roger Houck responded no, the dock will be the same size as the previous dock which is twenty-four foot (24) long by four foot (4) wide.

Jim Steen, Zoning Administrator told the Zoning Board members that this file will have to be sent to the APA; however, because the structure is under the APA's 100 square foot threshold the APA will not have jurisdiction over the project.

Charles Lewis asked if Roger Houck had the Authority to Act as Agent for the Property Owner form signed and Roger Houck responded yes it is included in the application.

Vice-Chair Cheryl Erickson made a motion to deem the application complete and set a public hearing for May 19, 2015. Second by Charles Lewis. ALL AYES.
